- All courses have been fully accredited only after scrutiny and review by the Academic Accreditation Committee of VŠE



- At least a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0-scale or equivalent good standing at the home university
- At least one year (2 semesters) finished at the home university
- English language knowledge
